

COVID-19 Policy and Waiver of Liability 2022 CA CLT Network Conference Oct. 13-14 — Los Angeles

While we are excited to gather in person for the 2022 CLT Conference we are also very aware that the COVID-19 Pandemic continues to pose a serious threat to ourselves and our communities. We are committed to holding this event in as safe a manner as possible while also recognizing that some members of our community may choose not to join because of health considerations.

We are committing to a set of safety precautions and we are asking all attendees to commit to the following

- 1) Taking an at-home COVID test within 24 hours before arriving at the conference and not attending if the test comes back positive.
- 2) Providing proof of vaccination
- 3) Wearing a mask while not actively eating, drinking, or presenting *is strongly recommended*

If an individual is unable or unwilling to comply with the requirements above, we ask that they do not attend the conference. There will be no exceptions.

In the event that the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and/or the City and County of Los Angeles adopt more cautionary guidelines, we will adjust our policy in accordance.

COVID Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability

Despite precautions taken, CACLTN cannot ensure that you will not be exposed to or contract COVID-19 as a result of participating in this event or related activities. By registering/attending this event, you acknowledge and understand all risks associated with possible exposure to and contraction of COVID-19, and are voluntarily participating in the event for your own benefit, the value of which is sufficient consideration for your voluntary execution of this agreement.

Attendee agrees to release and hold harmless CACLTN and its employees, officers, representatives, and agents from any and all claims, demands, and causes of action arising out of or relating to your participation in the event you are registering to participate in and use of any associated facilities.
