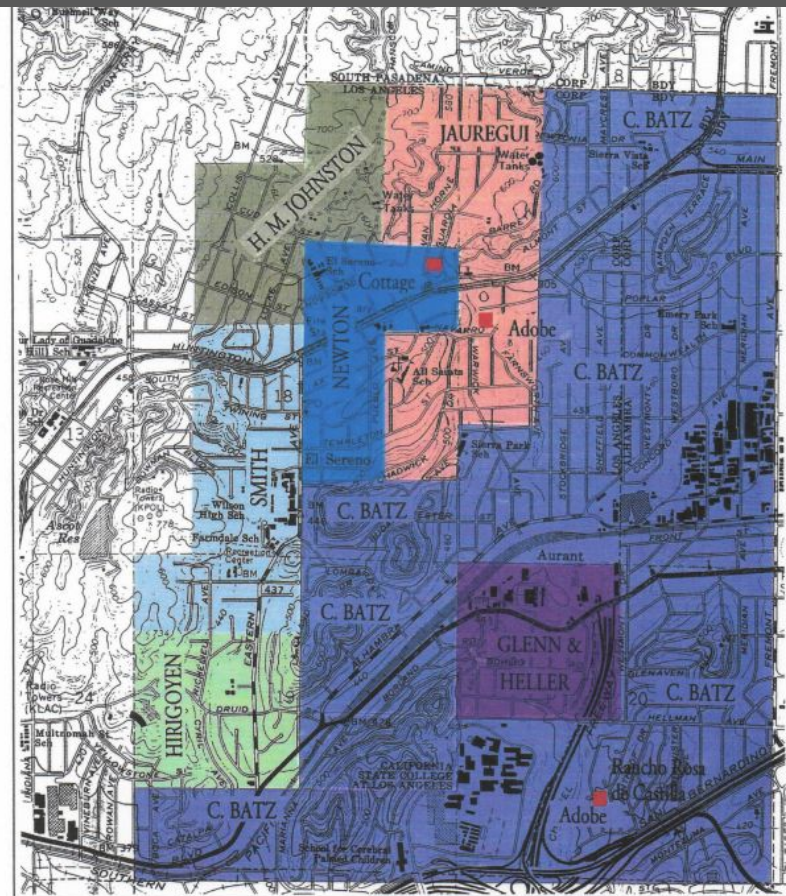








Map of Rancho Rosa de Castilla (Approximate Boundaries) El Sereno Historical Society **FIGURE 6**

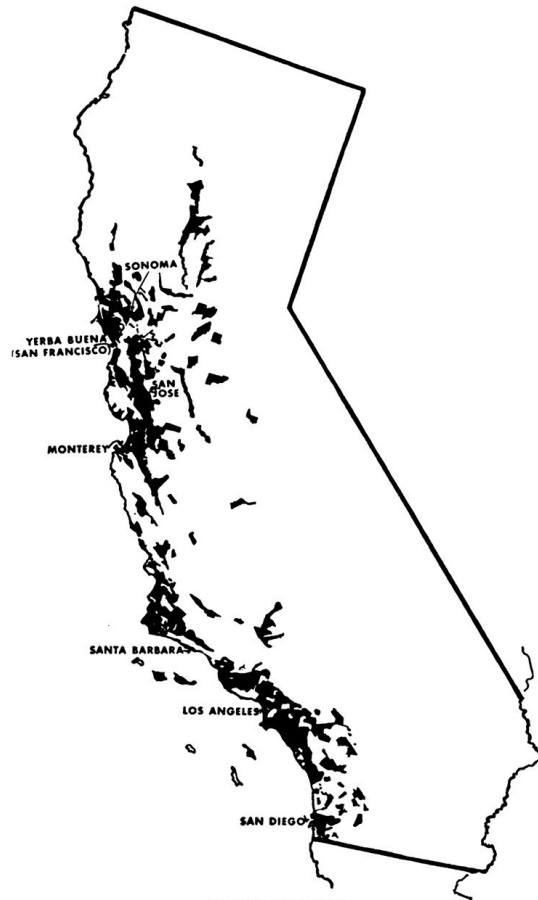

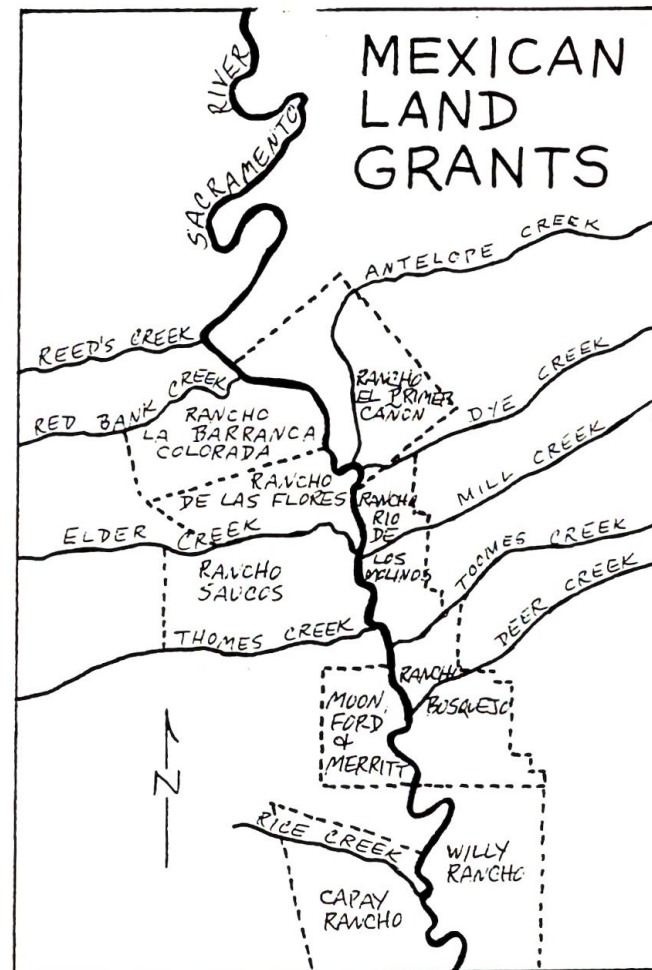

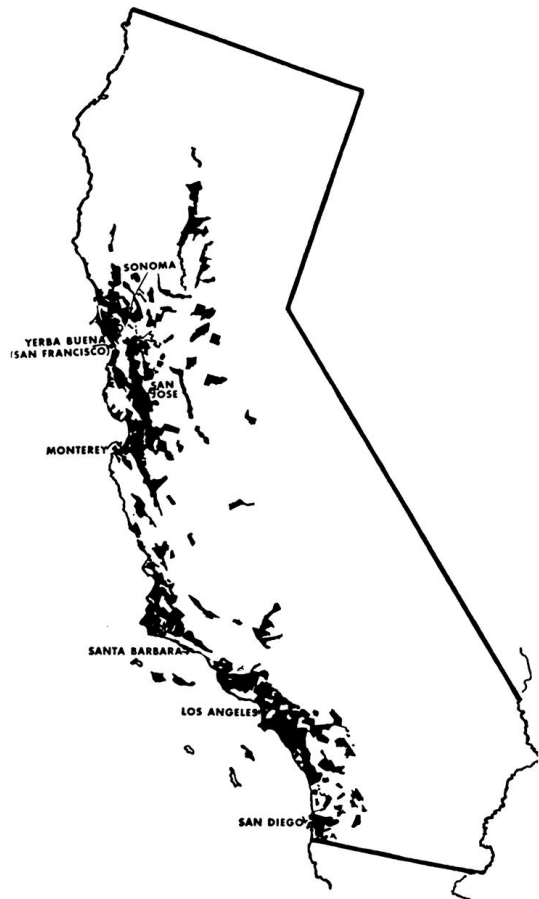

CALIFORNIA IN 1846

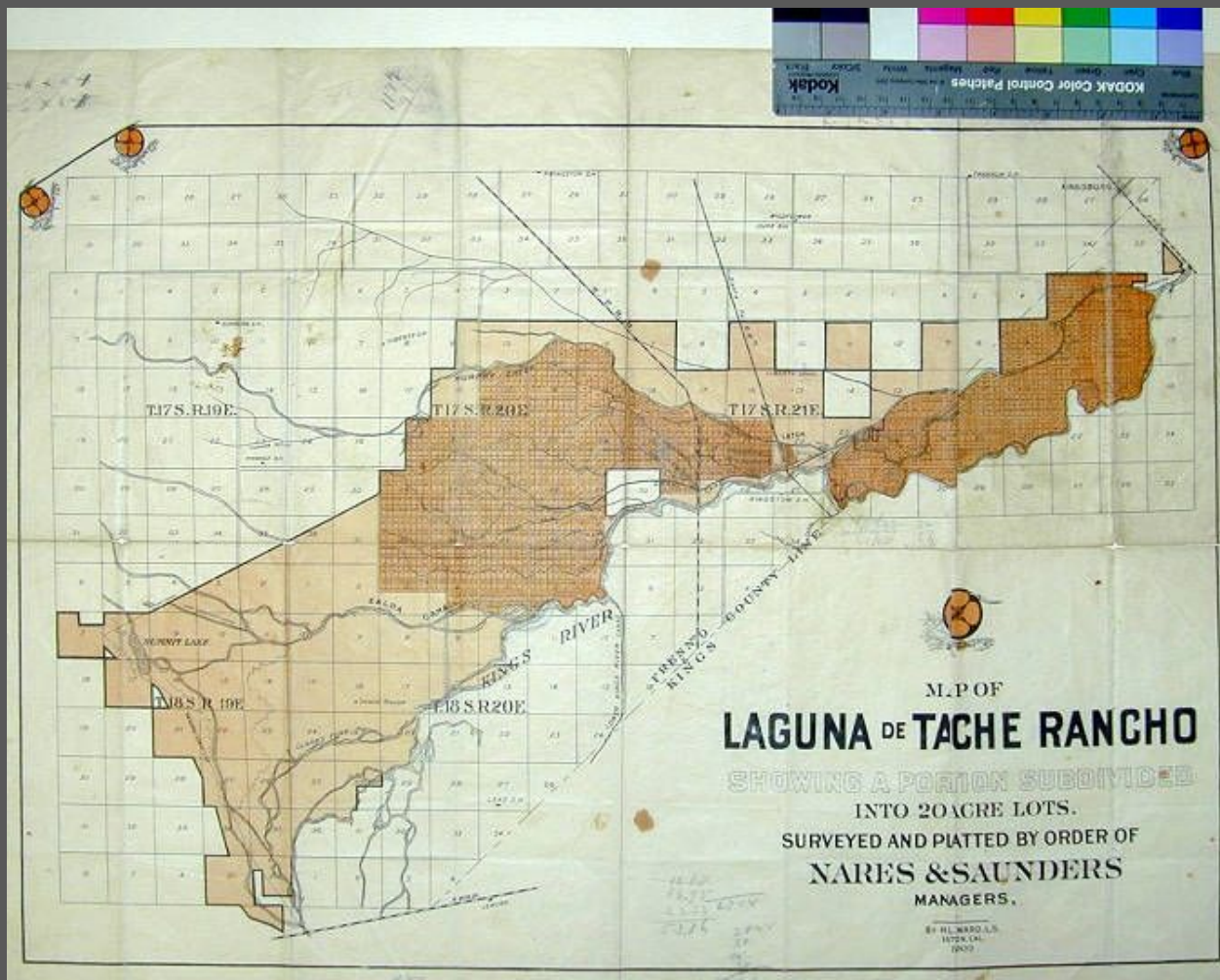

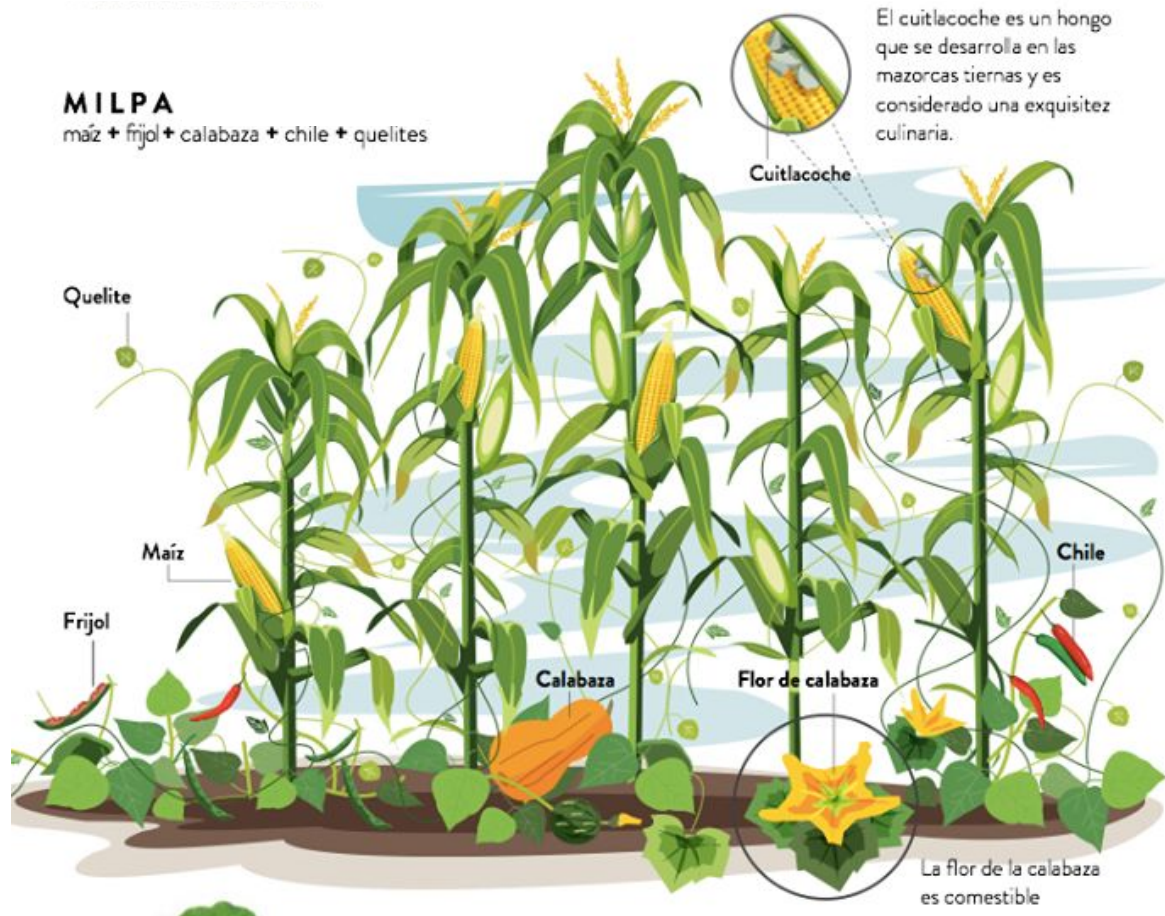


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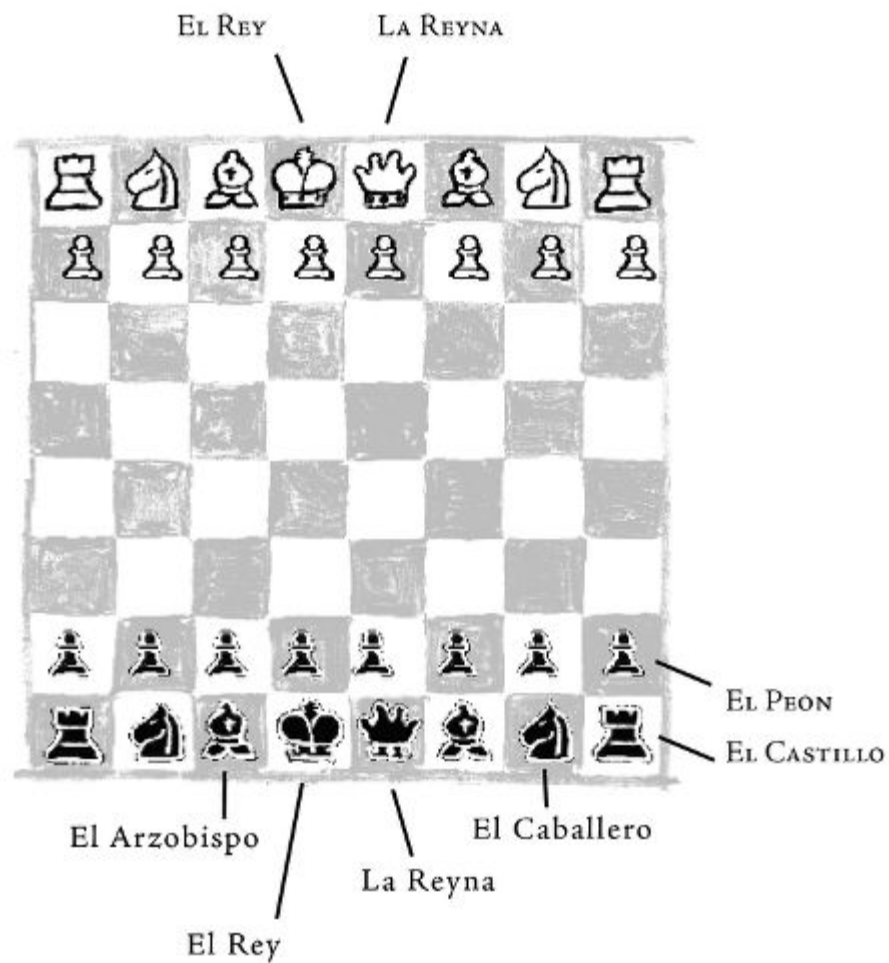
